You may wish to join in the spirit of the time and dress in the style of 1953, from bobby socks to blue suede shoes, beehives to braces, there is no dress code at Chitlyns! Dressing in clothes of the time is not a requirement but in our experience it definitely adds to the fun and sense of occasion - the most important thing is for our guests to feel comfortable to ensure they have the best possible time during the event.

You are a holiday maker at Chitlyn's holiday camp where 'Anything Goes'! All the suspects to any events that emerge during the evening will be characters presented by the actors of Playing Dead. You may wish to throw yourself into the action or sit back and enjoy the spectacle, the choice is yours - we are very skilled at spotting who wants to join in and who wants to sit and watch!

You can ask the characters as many questions as you like, but take care, they may have something to hide so could be telling you lies!
